EXISTING RULE 5

5. OFFICERS

- (a) The officers shall be the International President, the International Vice-President (who shall be President Elect), the Immediate Past International President and the Secretary. Each person shall take office immediately following the Annual General Meeting at which he is elected and hold office until he resigns or until the next Annual General Meeting.
- (b) An Association wishing to host the International Vice-Presidency must submit a nomination to the Annual General Meeting prior to that at which the appointment will be made. Nominations will only be accepted from Associations who contribute the full basic fee to the budget. The successful Association shall present its candidate at the Half Yearly Meeting immediately following the decision.
- (c) The Secretary shall be elected for a term of three years and be the only one eligible for re-election.
- (d) All officers must be former members of Round Table.

SUGGESTED AMENDMENT / ADDITION TO RULE 5

- (c) Candidates for the post of Secretary must be supported by their Association and their names notified to the Secretary in writing at least 14 days prior to the Annual General Meeting.
- (d) The Secretary shall be elected for a term of 3 years and may stand for a further term of 3 years.
- (e) In the event of more than one nomination to host the Vice-Presidency or more than one candidate for the post of Secretary, the Association or the candidate will be requested to address the Annual General Meeting. Guidelines on procedure will be issued by the Board prior to the AGM.
- (f) All Officers must be former members of Round Table.
